LEGAL STATUS, POWERS AND DUTIES AND TERRITORIAL BOUNDARIES

The Constitution of the State of Indiana charges the General Assembly with the responsibility of establishing and maintaining a system of public schools for all children in Indiana. Supervision of the schools is the responsibility of the Board of School Trustees elected by citizens of the respective school corporations.

The Vigo County Board of School Trustees, by the powers delegated to it by the General Assembly is responsible for carrying out certain mandatory laws and where the laws do not provide or prohibit, the Board shall establish and appraise the educational activities of the Vigo County School Corporation.

Type of School Corporation

The official name of the school corporation shall be: Vigo County School Corporation.

The Vigo County School Corporation is a “community school corporation” governed by a locally elected Board of School Trustees. The entity shall be a reorganized school corporation as reflected by the plan for the Reorganization of Vigo County Schools as submitted by the Vigo County School Reorganization Committee, said plan having been amended by action of the Board of School Trustees of the Vigo County School Corporation in 1976 and approved by the General Commission on Education of the State Board of Education in a meeting held July 7, 1976.

Territorial Extent of the School Corporation

The Vigo County School Corporation shall consist of the entire area of what is generally known as Vigo County, Indiana.
