**POLICY IMPLEMENTATION**  
**(ENFORCEMENT)**

The policies developed by the Board of School Trustees and the Administrative Regulations developed to implement policies are designed to increase the probability of an effective and efficient school system. Consequently, it is assumed that all employees of the school corporation and students willingly carry them out. In an attempt to insure equitable and just treatment of all, suggestions for changes in, revisions of, or additions to existing policies and regulations are welcomed and sought from both employees and students.

In the educational hierarchy, those in superordinate positions are responsible for informing those in subordinate positions of existing policies and regulations and for seeing that they are implemented in the spirit intended. Continuous disregard for School Board Policy and Administrative Regulations may be interpreted as willful neglect of duty and may constitute grounds for dismissal. Any employee who feels that he has been subject to arbitrary and/or capricious regulations may institute discussion with the appropriate superordinate office holder.
