STUDENT PARKING STICKERS

Each high school principal and/or his or her designees shall charge and collect a fee for the privilege of a student parking a motor vehicle on the high school parking lot. In exchange for the fee, a student shall be issued a parking sticker, which shall be affixed to the motor vehicle for which the sticker was issued in such manner and place as to enable high school administrators to identify motor vehicles and student drivers.

The superintendent of schools, or his designee, shall establish the price to be charged students for the issuance of a parking sticker each school year. The fee shall not exceed the total cost to the school of a parking sticker rounded to the next higher \$.25 (i.e., if the total cost to the school of the sticker is \$.97, the price to the student would be \$1.00). All parking sticker monies collected by a school will be maintained in a separate account and used solely for the purpose of replenishing the school's supply of parking stickers.

The fee charged for a parking sticker shall not be considered as creating a bailment to the Vigo County School Corporation of the motor vehicle for which the parking sticker was issued.

At the time a parking sticker is issued, a waiver and release form shall be executed by the vehicle owner.
