REGULATIONS - EMERGENCY PLANS

Warning System

The Superintendent of Schools, or designee, in cooperation with the Vigo County Civil Defense Office, will maintain an emergency warning system that will alert all school facilities simultaneously of impending threats to the welfare and safety of students and staff. The radio silent receiver system will not be used for any other dissemination of information without the concurrence of the emergency preparedness coordinator and the Vigo County Civil Defense Office.

Emergency Use of School Facilities

The use of school buildings, grounds, and property shall at all times be restricted to school purposes and to those purposes that are of general welfare to the community.

The Superintendent of Schools, or designee, shall have the authority under the clause "to those purposes that are of general welfare to the community" to make school facilities available as a public service during an emergency when requested by appropriate police or civil authorities. The Superintendent of Schools, Director of Facility Support and Transportation, and the building principal or supervisor shall be notified of the action taken. Supervision of the facility during its emergency use shall be provided by the police unit or governmental agency which declared the emergency.
