**CURRICULUM ADOPTION**

A dynamic instructional program requires ongoing alteration in the curriculum and courses of study.

Prior to November 1, the New Course Adoption Committee meets to review and to make recommendations for any potential new high school courses to be submitted for Board approval for adoption for the following school year. During the year of adoption, the Indiana Department of Education also sends information to the district about which courses have been dropped at the state level and/or which titles have changed, and these courses are listed in the Curriculum Guides that are adopted by the Board.

It is the policy of the board that no basic course of study shall be eliminated or new courses added without approval of the Board, nor shall any sharp alteration or reduction of a course of study be made without such approval.
