OCCUPATIONAL EDUCATION

Career Technology education shall be an integral part of the comprehensive high school curriculum. Career Technology education shall be geared to take into account technological and economic conditions and changes, and, as a core component of comprehensive education, shall share with other aspects of the curriculum the purpose of development of character and attitudes as well as skills. Guidance and counseling services shall be provided each student throughout his or her academic program and when the time comes for placement in his or her chosen career.

In an effort to meet the needs of all high school students, adults, post-graduates, and other community elements identified by their needs, the district shall provide: (a) Family and Consumer Science; (b) evening classes specializing in the courses wanted by adult students; (c) specialized short-term programs developed to meet specific needs of the community; (d) post-high school articulation for graduates of Career Technology programs; (e) continuous recruitment of students - both regular high school pupils and adults - into Career Technology programs; (f) diffusion of offered programs on all campuses of the district, with equal opportunities for participation available to all district students; and (g) an emphasis on career education as a vital part of the comprehensive curriculum for both youth and adults.

The Board shall provide for the continuing function of a Career Technology education advisory board which will serve as the coordinating body among the schools, the central administration, and the Board.
