ACCEPTANCE OF CREDIT FROM NON-ACCREDITED PROGRAM/SCHOOL

Students transferring from education programs or high schools that are not accredited by their State Department of Education into Vigo County School Corporation high schools may have up to twelve (12) credits accepted for an academic year (see IKFB-R). In order to receive a high school diploma from a Vigo County School Corporation high school, a student must meet the credit requirement in effect for that class and have earned at least have at least twelve (12) credits from the school awarding the diploma. In addition, the student must meet all requirements for graduation as stipulated by the Vigo County School Corporation and the Indiana Department of Education.
