TRANSFER OF CREDIT FROM FOREIGN COUNTRY

Students who have attended schools in other countries may have their credits verified by evaluation of their foreign school transcript by the principal. If a transcript is not available, as is the case with refugee students, the principal may approve subject grade level placement based upon examination. The examination may be either the adopted standardized achievement test or semester examinations. Upon successful completion of assigned classes, credit may be given for previous years of high school attendance not to exceed twelve (12) credits per academic year.

Students who are participants in a recognized foreign student exchange program, and are classified as seniors, may have credits allowed toward completion of a diploma. A regular diploma may be granted based upon the completion of a minimum of twelve (12) credits in one academic year.
