STUDENT WITHDRAWAL FROM SCHOOL

In accordance with State Law, any student who is at least sixteen (16) years of age, but is not yet eighteen (18) years of age, may withdraw from school only after an exit interview has been concluded with said students' parents/guardians and principal with permission granted by both parents/guardians and principal. A student may not withdraw from school unless the withdrawal is due to (1) financial hardship and the student must be employed in order to support the family; (2) the student's illness; or (3) an order of a court with jurisdiction over the student.
